6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to judicial compensation; and pro-
7 viding for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 22.05.140(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) The chief justice and each associate justice shall receive
11 \$42,500 [\$36,000] annually as compensation. The compensation is payable
12 monthly in 12 equal installments. Compensation of the chief justice
13 or of an associate justice shall not be diminished during his term
14 of office, unless by general law applying to all salaried officers of
15 the state.

16 * Sec. 2. AS 22.10.190(a) is amended to read:

17 (a) Each superior court judge shall receive \$40,000 [\$33,000]
18 annually, as compensation, payable monthly in 12 equal installments.
19 The compensation of a judge shall not be diminished during his term
20 of office, unless by general law applying to all salaried officers of
21 the state.

22 * Sec. 3. AS 22.15.220(a) is amended to read:

23 (a) Each district judge shall receive \$33,000 [\$25,000] annually
24 as compensation, payable monthly in 12 equal installments.

25 * Sec. 4. This Act takes effect on July 16, 1972.
