5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Joint State-Federal Natural
7 Resources and Land Use Planning Commission."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 44.19.764(a)(1) is repealed.

10 * Sec. 2. AS 44.19.764(a)(2) is amended to read:

11 (2) two members of the Alaska legislature: the chairman of
12 the resources committee of the senate and the chairman of the resources
13 committee of the house of representatives, or their designees who shall
14 likewise be members of the legislature; and

15 * Sec. 3. AS 44.19.764 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

16 (c) The designees authorized in (a)(2) of this section do not
17 replace the resources chairmen as members of the commission, but may
18 attend meetings of the commission with the chairmen and sit as voting
19 members of the commission at meetings the chairmen are unable to
20 attend. The designees named by the chairmen under the authority of (a)
21 (2) of this section are entitled to per diem at the rate of \$35.00 per
22 day and travel expenses authorized for commission members under sec.
23 766 of this chapter, but shall receive no other compensation.

24 * Sec. 4. AS 44.19.764 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

25 (d) Until December 31, 1976, at least one member appointed by the
26 Governor shall be an Alaskan who is eligible for enrollment under the
27 Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act, PL 92-203, 85 Stat. 688.
