For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Board of Regents of the

University of Alaska; and providing for an effective

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 14.40.120 is amended to read:

11

Sec. 14.40.120. UNIVERSITY GOVERNED BY BOARD OF REGENTS. The

12

University of Alaska shall be governed by a Board of Regents consisting

13

of 11 [EIGHT] regents.

14

* Sec. 2. AS 14.40.140 is amended to read:

15

Sec. 14.40.140. TERM OF OFFICE. Except for a student regent as

16

specified in sec. 150(b) of this chapter, the [THE] term of office of

17

a regent is eight years. The term of office begins on the first Monday

18

in February of the year in which the appointment is made. Each regent

19

serves until his successor is appointed and qualifies. No regent may

20

serve more than one full eight-year term. However, if a regent is

21

appointed to fill an unexpired term, he may complete that term and be

22

reappointed to one full eight-year term. A regent who has completed

23

one full eight-year term may not be reappointed to the board until one

24

year has elapsed. No regent may serve more than two consecutive one-

25

year terms as president of the board.

* Sec. 3. AS 14.40.150 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

27

(b) At least one member of the Board of Regents shall be a full-

28

time student, appointed from a list of two students submitted to the

29

governor from each campus site of the University of Alaska after an

1 election is held at each campus site. Elections shall be conducted
2 under rules established by the Governor's Commission on the Involvement
3 of Young People in Government (AS 44.19.777 - 44.19.787). The term of
4 office of a student regent is two years. For purposes of this sub-
5 section, "full-time student" means

6 (1) a person who, at the time of appointment and while serv-
7 ing, is enrolled in courses at the University of Alaska equal to 15
8 academic credit hours or the equivalent of 15 academic credit hours in
9 career education, including but not limited to vocational and technical
10 programs, or

11 (2) a person who, at the time of appointment and while serv-
12 ing, is enrolled in graduate courses at the University of Alaska equal
13 to 10 graduate academic credit hours.

14 * Sec. 4. AS 14.40.200 is amended to read:

15 Sec. 14.40.200. QUORUM. No corporate business may be transacted
16 at any meeting of the Board of Regents unless at least six [FIVE]
17 regents are present, the majority of the whole board to approve the
18 same.

19 * Sec. 5. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval
20 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
