6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the publication of an Alaska
7 Blue Book."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 44.19 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 44.19.035. ALASKA BLUE BOOK. (a) The lieutenant governor
11 shall compile and issue biennially, beginning in 1973, an official
12 directory of all state officers, state departments, agencies, institu-
13 tions, boards and commissions and borough officials, to be known as
14 the Alaska Blue Book, and include in the book information regarding
15 the functions of these officers and agencies that he considers most
16 valuable to the people of the state, together with other data and
17 information that is usually included in similar publications of other
18 states. The book shall also include a synopsis of all studies under-
19 taken by each of the agencies listed.

20 (b) In order to carry out the purposes of this section, the
21 lieutenant governor may request of any state or borough official any
22 information concerning their offices, departments, agencies or insti-
23 tutions that he decides to include in the Alaska Blue Book. The
24 officials shall furnish the information requested.

25 (c) The lieutenant governor may distribute the Alaska Blue Book
26 free of charge, under regulations he may adopt, to schools and to
27 state, borough and city officials in the state.

28 (d) The lieutenant governor shall determine a reasonable price,
29 and charge that price for each copy of the Alaska Blue Book distributed

to the general public. The money collected shall be deposited in the
general fund.
