5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act incorporating the development city of Lost  
7 River; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. In accordance with AS 29.76.020(2), the development city of  
10 Lost River is incorporated.

11 \* Sec. 2. The initial boundaries of Lost River are as follows: Beginning  
12 at the SW corner of Unsurveyed T1N, R42W, Kateel River Meridian, Alaska;  
13 thence W along the S boundary of T1N, R45W, to the point of intersection with  
14 the mean low water of the Bering Sea; thence S a distance of three miles,  
15 which point lies in the Bering Sea; thence in an easterly direction parallel-  
16 ing the mean low water of the Bering Sea and always at a distance of three  
17 miles S of the mean low water of the Bering Sea to the point where this line  
18 intersects the E boundary of T2S, R40W; thence N to the NE corner of T1S,  
19 R40W; thence W to the SE corner of T1N, R40W; thence N to the NE corner of  
20 T2N, R40W; thence W to the NW corner of T2N, R42W; thence S to the point of  
21 beginning, containing 356 square miles, more or less.

22 \* Sec. 3. The Lost River Mining Corporation, the developer corporation  
23 of the development city of Lost River, shall provide the Local Boundary Com-  
24 mission with the information required under AS 29.76.030.

25 \* Sec. 4. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval  
26 or on the day it becomes law without approval.  
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
