5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act incorporating the development city of Lost  
7 River; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. In accordance with AS 29.76.020(2), the development city of  
10 Lost River is incorporated.

11 \* Sec. 2. The initial boundaries of Lost River are as follows: Beginning  
12 at the SW corner of Unsurveyed T1N, R42W, Kateel River Meridian, Alaska;  
13 thence W along the S boundary of T1N, R43W, to the point of intersection  
14 with the mean high water of the Bering Sea; thence E along the mean high  
15 water of the Bering Sea, to a point three miles W of the E boundary of T1S,  
16 R42W, thence S a distance of three miles, which point lies in the Bering Sea;  
17 thence in an easterly direction paralleling the mean high water of the  
18 Bering Sea and always at a distance of three miles S of the mean high water  
19 of the Bering Sea to a point where this line intersects a point three miles  
20 from the mean high water of the Bering Sea three miles east of the east  
21 boundary of T1S R42W, thence north to mean high water thence in an easterly  
22 direction along the mean high water of the Bering Sea to the E boundary of T1S  
23 R41W; thence N to the NE corner of T1S, R41W; thence E to the SE corner of  
24 T1N, R40W; thence N to the NE corner of T1N, R40W; thence W to the NW corner  
25 of T1N, R42W; thence S to the point of beginning, containing 170 square  
26 miles, more or less.

27 \* Sec. 3. The Lost River Mining Corporation, the developer corporation  
28 of the development city of Lost River, shall provide the state with plans  
29 and information required under AS 29.76 and other applicable provisions of

1 this title.

2 \* Sec. 4. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval  
3 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
