6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to retirement pay for justices and  
7 judges; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 22.25.020 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 22.25.020. RETIREMENT PAY. (a) Except as provided in (b)  
11 of this section a [A] retired justice or judge eligible for retirement  
12 pay shall receive from the date of his eligibility until his death  
13 monthly compensation equal to five per cent per year of service, to  
14 a maximum of 75 per cent, of the monthly salary authorized for justices  
15 and judges, respectively, at the time each retirement payment is made.

16 \* Sec. 2. AS 22.25.020 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

17 (b) A justice or judge who has served 10 years and who retires  
18 because of mental or physical disabilities caused by performing his  
19 judicial duties shall receive from the date of his eligibility until  
20 his death monthly compensation equal to 75 per cent of the monthly salary  
21 authorized for justices and judges, respectively, at the time each  
22 retirement payment is made.

23 \* Sec. 3. This Act is retrospective to July 1, 1971.

24 \* Sec. 4. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval  
25 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
