6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to game preserves."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 11.40.510 is amended to read:

9 Sec. 11.40.510. USE OF LIVE BRIDS AS TARGETS. A person who

10 (1) uses a live pigeon, fowl or other bird as a target, or to be shot
11 at either for amusement or as a test of skill in marksmanship; or

12 (2) shoots at a bird used as a target, for amusement or as a test
13 of skill in marksmanship, or is a party to a shooting; or (3) leases
14 a building, room, field or premises, or knowingly permits the use of
15 them for a shooting, is guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction
16 is punishable by a fine of not more than \$50. This section does not
17 apply to shooting of game for food or prohibit recreational hunting of
18 game birds on game hunting preserves authorized by the Fish and Game
19 Board under AS 16.05.930(c).

20 * Sec. 2. AS 16.05.930(c) is amended to read:

21 (c) Section 920 of this chapter does not prohibit rearing and
22 sale of fish from private ponds, [OR] the raising of wild animals in
23 captivity for food or fur purposes or the raising of game birds for the
24 purpose of recreational hunting on game hunting preserves, under
25 regulations promulgated by the board.
