5 Relating to restaking winter trails

6 between certain villages in Alaska.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS, at the present time, winter trails are not being restaked from

9 (1) Bethel to Nunapitchuk to Kasigluk and

10 (2) Bethel to Eek to Quinhagak to Goodnews Bay and

11 (3) Bethel to Tuntatuliak to Kongiganak to Kwigillingok to Kipnuk  
12 to Chefornak to Nightmute to Toksook Bay to Tununak to Newtok; and

13 WHEREAS these trails are essential arteries for the transportation of  
14 supplies and are also in constant use by subsistence hunters and trappers;  
15 and

16 WHEREAS travel for the inhabitants of these areas is carried on at the  
17 constant risk of life even without the added danger of becoming lost;

18 BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of the State of Alaska respectfully  
19 requests the Department of Highways to restake these winter trails which  
20 are so essential to existence during these months, and to complete the pro-  
21 ject by the close of 1971.
