5 Relating to overtime compensation
6 of state employees.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS, as of December 16, 1970, the state adopted new rules regarding
9 the payment of overtime to state employees; and

10 WHEREAS the state employees who are eligible to receive compensation
11 for overtime depend upon and budget their family needs and necessities on
12 the amount of money they expect to receive each monthly pay period; and

13 WHEREAS many state employees, and for some unknown reason, particularly
14 employees in the Fairbanks area who have been notified they are eligible
15 for overtime have not received overtime payments when due; and

16 WHEREAS, in certain instances this group of people includes persons who
17 have always received and depended upon overtime and as a result of not
18 receiving overtime payments since the new system became effective, they are
19 actually taking home less pay than before;

20 BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislature that the Department of Administration
21 is requested to immediately report to the Legislature on the full implementa-
22 tion of the new overtime policies, including but not limited to an explana-
23 tion of why any eligible employees have not yet received their wages and
24 when payment may be expected.
