5 Honoring Phillip M. Holland.

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

7 WHEREAS Phillip M. Holland, one of Alaska's outstanding young citizens,
8 has met an untimely death; and

9 WHEREAS, although at the time of his death he was only 25 years of age,
10 he had already contributed greatly to the development of his community and
11 fellow citizens both of the state and the nation; and

12 WHEREAS his accomplishments included service as president of the student
13 body at the University of Alaska, establishment of the first university-
14 sponsored free tutorial program for children in the North Star Borough,
15 service as a member of the United States President's Special Study Group
16 on Student Stress during 1967-68, and many other activities of a civic
17 nature, all toward the goal of aiding his community and fellowman; and

18 WHEREAS at the time of his death he was in service to his country as
19 an agricultural specialist in the Peace Corps assigned to rural India;

20 BE IT RESOLVED that the Seventh Alaska State Legislature extends its
21 most sincere condolences to the family of Phillip M. Holland and that this
22 Resolution serve as an expression of high regard and esteem for the dedica-
23 tion and faithful service to his fellowmen which Phillip M. Holland
24 practiced, without fail, for the totality of his life.
