5 Commending Bruce Kendall.

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

7 WHEREAS Mr. Bruce Kendall, former Speaker of the Alaska House of
8 Representatives, a business leader in the Anchorage community who operates
9 the Roosevelt Hotel and other enterprises, has encouraged the involvement
10 of youth in democracy by transporting sixteen Alaska high school students
11 to the state capital from their homes in or near Anchorage, for the purpose
12 of observing government in action; and

13 WHEREAS by such an investment in Alaska's youth and our way of life
14 Mr. Kendall and the Roosevelt Hotel are promoting interest and understanding
15 of our system of government; and

16 WHEREAS it is the policy of the State of Alaska, as emphasized by
17 Governor Egan in his 1971 "State of the State" message, and by other leaders,
18 to encourage youth involvement and participation; and

19 WHEREAS the high school students selected for the trip to Juneau were
20 chosen by faculty members at their respective high schools on an impartial
21 basis, thus further stimulating and motivating youth interest in state
22 governmental affairs;

23 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature commends Bruce Kendall
24 for an outstanding civic contribution and encourages other business leaders
25 to follow this example with a view to spreading broader understanding of
26 state government among resident Alaska youths.
