4 SEVENTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to a study of the Alaska  
6 Criminal Code.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS, due to expression of concern by the Alaska Bar Association  
9 and individual members of the Alaska Bar for several years, the legislature  
10 passed 1965 House Concurrent Resolution No. 20, requesting the Legislative  
11 Council to prepare a revised criminal code; and

12 WHEREAS that revision has been repeatedly introduced in the legislature  
13 for the last six years, it being Senate Bill No. 5 in the current legisla-  
14 ture; and

15 WHEREAS, since the original drafting of Senate Bill No. 5, many other  
16 states have revised their criminal codes and newer additions of various  
17 model criminal codes have been published; and

18 WHEREAS the time remaining in this First Session of the Seventh State  
19 Legislature is insufficient to study this matter properly;

20 BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council is requested to re-examine  
21 Senate Bill No. 5 in the light of these more recent publications with the  
22 goal of preparing a report and substitute bill for the Second Session of the  
23 Seventh State Legislature, and to conduct public hearings on the criminal  
24 code in appropriate locations in the state and solicit analysis and comment  
25 from the bar associations in the state.
