2 SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 41

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 SEVENTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to public service announce-  
6 ments at the Anchorage International  
7 Airport.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS several thousand persons arrive or depart from the now expanded  
10 Anchorage International Airport each day; and

11 WHEREAS many of these persons, while awaiting the departure or arrival  
12 of flights avail themselves of the fine restaurant, lounge, and other  
13 facilities located in the airport complex; and

14 WHEREAS at the present time flight announcements are not made in the  
15 public areas of the airport by the various airlines; and

16 WHEREAS, because of such lack of flight announcements, many members  
17 of the public suffer inconveniences and aggravating circumstances through  
18 no fault of their own and for some the practice has resulted in more than  
19 mere inconvenience and aggravation; and

20 WHEREAS the state has recently completed the installation of public  
21 address facilities throughout the Anchorage International Airport terminal;  
22 and

23 WHEREAS, should the state find it desirable, as a public service, to  
24 provide flight announcements, in absence of such services by the various  
25 airlines operating at the terminal, the cost of such services would of  
26 necessity require the imposition of additional airport user fees or aviation  
27 fuel taxes; and

28 WHEREAS the individual airlines should be able to provide flight an-  
29 nouncement services more economically than could the state;

1 BE IT RESOLVED by the Seventh State Legislature that all airlines  
2 operating out of the Anchorage International Airport are urged to provide  
3 flight announcements in the public areas of the terminal for the convenience  
4 of flight and airport customers.

5 COPIES of this Resolution shall be sent to all airlines using the  
6 Anchorage International Airport.
