IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

SEVENTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

Commending Kathy O'Donnell.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS Miss Kathy O'Donnell, a senior in the Vocational Marketing and Distribution Program at Dimond High School in Anchorage was recently awarded first place in "Display" competition at the 25th Distributive Education Clubs of America National Leadership Conference; and
