5 Relating to a Public Safety Academy in
6 Sitka, Alaska.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the State Department of Public Safety currently provides in-
9 valuable services by conducting training programs for firemen, local law
10 enforcement officers, and the state troopers, and also in related emergency
11 services; and

12 WHEREAS the Public Safety Academy now utilizes classrooms, dormitories
13 and offices at Sheldon Jackson Junior College; and

14 WHEREAS it has been acknowledged that the department may have to
15 vacate the existing space at Sheldon Jackson in the near future; and

16 WHEREAS Sitka has proven to be an ideal location for the Public Safety
17 Academy because of accessibility and the community has created an atmosphere
18 conducive to the highest academic achievements;

19 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska Legislature that the Governor is respect-
20 fully requested to direct the Department of Public Safety to take all
21 action necessary, and immediately to assure the continued existence of the
22 Public Safety Academy at Sitka, either at Sheldon Jackson Junior College,
23 or at another existing facility, or one which will be constructed for that
24 purpose.
