5 Relating to a study of mandatory
6 contributions by state employees
7 under the Federal Insurance Contri-
8 butions Act.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 WHEREAS currently all employees of the State of Alaska are required to
11 contribute to Social Security; and

12 WHEREAS many state employees have expressed a desire that mandatory
13 extension of the federal old age and survivors insurance system be eliminated;
14 and

15 WHEREAS many jurisdictions give their state employees the option of
16 paying into Social Security or not; and

17 WHEREAS many employees will never receive any of the benefits of the
18 federal old age and survivors insurance program and contribute to other
19 varied retirement programs;

20 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska Legislature that the Legislative Council
21 make a report on the economic and social impact to the state employees and
22 the state if mandatory social security payments were eliminated; and be it

23 FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council's report with its recommendations,
24 be given to the First Session of the Eighth Legislature.
