5 Relating to assistance of the Legis-
6 lature at the fourth annual Girls'
7 State.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS the fourth annual Girls' State program will be held on the
10 campus and facilities of the University of Alaska, at Fairbanks, Alaska, in
11 June 1972; and

12 WHEREAS at Girls' State the delegates learn the duties of the various
13 offices connected with city, borough, and state government; and

14 WHEREAS part of the program connected with state government is the
15 election of a legislature, and the introduction and debate upon bills in
16 accordance with regular legislative procedure; and

17 WHEREAS the Legislature could be of valuable aid to the operation of
18 the fourth annual Girls' State program, by having the Legislative Affairs
19 Agency prepare materials necessary for a better understanding of the legis-
20 lative process and by having designated legislators and Agency staff members
21 in attendance at Girls' State to aid in any way possible with the legislative
22 program;

23 BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature direct the Legislative Council to
24 authorize the Legislative Affairs Agency within the limits of its appropria-
25 tions to assist in the preparation of legislative materials and, on request
26 of the Girls' State chairmen, to have legislators designated by the presiding
27 officer of each house and two Agency staff members attend the fourth annual
28 Girls' State to aid the delegates in the legislative program.
