5 Relating to Law Day U.S.A.

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

7 WHEREAS the cornerstone of American society is the legal profession, in
8 all its differing capacities, which provides for the orderly settlement of
9 disputes and without which chaos would reign supreme; and

10 WHEREAS the members of the legal profession are dedicated to the demo-
11 cratic form of government and the principle that ours is a government of
12 law, not of men; and

13 WHEREAS the ultimate philosophy of Americans everywhere should be that
14 the welfare of the people shall be the supreme law;

15 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska Legislature that the Governor is respect-
16 fully requested to proclaim May 1 as Law Day U.S.A., not a holiday, but a
17 day during which all Alaskans could reflect and rededicate themselves to
18 the principles of democracy and to weigh the enormous responsibilities of
19 each citizen in pursuing the principles of our democracy.
