3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 SEVENTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Relating to the construction of
6 bush airfield facilities.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS it is the desire of the legislature to provide at least minimal
9 airfields in all communities of Alaska having no other means of transporta-
10 tion during large portions of the year; and

11 WHEREAS some communities, though large enough to qualify for school
12 facilities, do not have any airfield facilities whatsoever; and

13 WHEREAS the legislature intends that communities with, or which qualify
14 for, school facilities and which do not have airfields of any sort be given
15 the highest priority for available money before money is spent to improve
16 existing airfield facilities; and

17 WHEREAS there may be additional bond money available for bush airfield
18 construction in the near future;

19 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska Legislature that if additional money is
20 approved by the voters in the 1972 general election for bush airfields,
21 that the governor is respectfully requested to direct the Department of
22 Public Works to give those communities which have school facilities but do
23 not have existing airport facilities the high priority in the programming
24 and construction of any bush airfields.
