Relating to physical education in

Alaska schools.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

WHEREAS physical education is not now a required activity for many of

9

Alaska's children; and

WHEREAS it has been demonstrated beyond doubt that regular physical

11

exercise is of primary importance to the development and maintenance of

12

sound, healthy bodies; and

13

WHEREAS it is also known to be true that persons who are healthy in

14

body also acquire higher grades, develop more self-worth and have less ten-

15

dency to concentrate their energies in antisocial ways; and

16

WHEREAS regular physical education programs could be instituted in the

17

schools of Alaska with a minimum of expense and administrative detail;

18

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska Legislature that school administrators and

19

school boards throughout Alaska are respectfully requested to give the utmost

20

consideration to the institution of regular physical education activities

21

which would be required for all students, at least from the seventh through

22

the twelfth grades.

COPIES of this resolution shall be sent to each school board president

24

and to each junior and senior high school principal in the state.
