5 Proposing an amendment to the Consti-
6 tution of the State of Alaska limit-
7 ing legislators seeking or holding
8 other public office.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. Sec. 5, art. II of the Constitution of the State of Alaska
11 is amended to read:

12 SECTION 5. DISQUALIFICATIONS. No legislator may hold any other
13 office or position of profit under the United States or the State.
14 During the term for which elected and for one year thereafter, no
15 legislator may be nominated, elected, or appointed to any other office
16 or position of profit under the State which has been created, or the
17 salary or emoluments of which have been increased, unless by general
18 law applying to all salaried officers of the State, while he was a
19 member. A legislator may not seek [THIS SECTION SHALL NOT PREVENT ANY
20 PERSON FROM SEEKING OR HOLDING] the office of governor, or lieutenant
21 governor, without first having resigned his seat in the legislature
22 [OR MEMBER OF CONGRESS]. This section shall not apply to employment
23 by or election to a constitutional convention, or to service on or
24 at the behest of an interim committee of the legislature.

25 * Sec. 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution shall be placed
26 before the voters of the state at the next statewide election in conformity
27 with sec. 1, art. XIII of the Constitution of the State of Alaska, and the
28 state election laws.
