2 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 30

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 SEVENTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to Alaskan-produced oil.

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

7 WHEREAS it is acknowledged that there is an immediate need for
8 extraction of Alaskan oil from the source so that a pending energy crisis
9 may be met by the United States; and

10 WHEREAS not only does the United States need at the earliest possible
11 time Alaskan oil as an additional energy source, but in future years the
12 entire defense posture of the United States will also be dependent upon
13 the Alaskan crude oil supply; and

14 WHEREAS the Alaskan crude oil is reputed to be of the highest possible
15 quality, thus making it an attractive item of export from the viewpoint of
16 other nations facing an energy crisis; and

17 WHEREAS, because of the great demand for the world's crude oil supplies,
18 commercial interests may be tempted to divert Alaskan crude oil to the use
19 of other nations; and

20 WHEREAS the United States will need and can use all of the oil which
21 will be produced in Alaska and it would be extremely unwise and harmful to
22 the nation and all the nation's citizens if the United States alone were
23 not to benefit from the Alaskan crude oil supply;

24 BE IT RESOLVED by the Seventh Alaska Legislature that the federal
25 government is urged to take whatever action is necessary to ensure that all
26 oil produced in Alaska be utilized in the United States for the benefit of
27 all of our people and that Alaskan oil not be permitted to be exported to
28 foreign countries for whatever purpose.

7 Nick Begich, U. S. Representative, members of the Alaska delegation in
8 Congress.
