IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
SEVENTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

Proposing an amendment to the state
constitution relating to the members
of the state legislature.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. Sec. 2, art. II, Constitution of the State of Alaska is
amended to read:

SECTION 2. MEMBERS: QUALIFICATIONS. A member of the legislature
shall be a qualified voter who has been a resident of Alaska for at
least three years and of an area which is, or at one time was, a
portion of the district from which elected for at least six months,
[ONE YEAR, IMMEDIATELY] preceding his filing for office. A member of
the legislature [SENATOR] shall be at least [TWENTY-FIVE YEARS OF AGE
AND A REPRESENTATIVE AT LEAST] twenty-one years of age.

* Sec. 2. The amendment proposed by this Resolution shall be placed
before the voters of the state at the next statewide election in conformity
with sec. 1, art. XIII, Constitution of the State of Alaska, and the
election laws of the state.

* Sec. 3. If the amendment proposed in sec. 1 of this Resolution is
approved by the voters the change in the membership qualifications in
accordance with the provisions of sec. 1, art. II, Constitution of the
State of Alaska, as amended by this Resolution, shall be effective beginning
with the next regular election of members of the Legislature.
