5 Proposing an amendment to the state  
6 constitution relating to the quali-  
7 fications of members of the state  
8 legislature.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. Sec. 2, art. II, Constitution of the State of Alaska, is  
11 repealed and re-adopted to read:

12 SECTION 2. MEMBERSHIP QUALIFICATIONS. A member of the legisla-  
13 ture shall be a qualified voter who, immediately preceding his filing  
14 for office, has been

15 (1) a resident of Alaska for at least three years; and

16 (2) for at least six months, a resident of an area which,  
17 under the plan for redistricting and reapportionment in effect for the  
18 immediately preceding election, was a portion of the district from  
19 which he was elected.

20 \* Sec. 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution shall be placed  
21 before the voters of the state at the next statewide election in conformity  
22 with sec. 1, art. XIII, Constitution of the State of Alaska, and the elec-  
23 tion laws of the state.

24 \* Sec. 3. If the amendment proposed in sec. 1 of this resolution is  
25 approved by the voters the change in the membership qualifications in accor-  
26 dance with the provisions of sec. 2, art. II, Constitution of the State of  
27 Alaska, as amended by this resolution, shall be effective beginning with the  
28 next regular election of members of the legislature.
