BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGILATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. Sec. 2, art. II, Constitution of the State of Alaska, is

repealed and re-adopted to read:

SECTION 2. MEMBERSHIP QUALIFICATIONS. A member of the legislature

13

shall be a qualified voter who, immediately preceding his filing for

14

office, has been

15

(1) a resident of Alaska for at least three years.

16

\* Sec. 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution shall be placed be-

17

fore the voters of the state at the next statewide election in conformity with

18

sec. 1, art. XIII, Constitution of the State of Alaska, and the election laws

19

of the state.

20

\* Sec. 3. If the amendment proposed in sec. 1 of this resolution is

21

approved by the voters the change in the membership qualifications in accor-

22

dance with the provisions of sec. 2, art. II, Constitution of the State of

23

Alaska, as amended by this resolution, shall be effective beginning with the

24

next regular election of members of the legislature.
