2 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 50

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 SEVENTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Requesting navigational aids in  
6 certain areas of Alaska.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS there are areas of the state that currently have either inade-  
9 quate or no navigational aids; and

10 WHEREAS persons who have to operate boats in waters of the state that  
11 do not contain navigational aids risk not only great property damage, but the  
12 loss of life; and

13 WHEREAS navigational aids not only protect the citizens of Alaska but  
14 provide an economic impetus to areas where water transportation is possible;

15 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the United States  
16 Coast Guard is respectfully requested to install suitable and necessary  
17 navigational aids in the mouths of the Kongiganak and Kwigillingok Rivers,  
18 and in the south, middle and north mouths of the Yukon River.

20 Secretary of the Department of Transportation; Admiral Chester R. Bender,  
21 Commandant, U.S. Coast Guard; Rear Admiral James Palmer, Commander, 17th

23 Gravel, U.S. Senators, and the Honorable Nick Begich, U.S. Representative,  
24 members of the Alaska delegation in Congress.
