SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 51 *AM*  
IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA  
SEVENTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

Proposing an amendment to the  
section establishing the age  
qualification of legislators.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. Sec. 2, art. II of the Constitution of the State of Alaska  
is amended to read:

SECTION 2. MEMBERS' QUALIFICATIONS. A member of the legislature  
shall be a qualified voter who has been a resident of Alaska for at  
least three years and of the district from which elected for at least  
one year, immediately preceding his filing for office. A senator shall  
be at least twenty-one [TWENTY-FIVE] and a representative at least  
eighteen [TWENTY-ONE] years of age.

\* Sec. 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution shall be placed  
before the voters of the state at the next statewide election in conformity  
with sec. 1, art. XIII of the Constitution of the State of Alaska, and the  
state election laws.
