5 Proposing an amendment to the
6 section establishing the age
7 qualification of legislators.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. Sec. 2, art. II of the Constitution of the State of Alaska
10 is amended to read:

11 SECTION 2. MEMBERS' QUALIFICATIONS. A member of the legislature
12 shall be a qualified voter who has been a resident of Alaska for at
13 least three years and of the district from which elected for at least
14 one year, immediately preceding his filing for office. [A SENATOR
15 SHALL BE AT LEAST TWENTY-FIVE YEARS OF AGE AND A REPRESENTATIVE AT
16 LEAST TWENTY-ONE YEARS OF AGE.]

17 *Sec. 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution shall be placed
18 before the voters of the state at the next statewide election in conformity
19 with sec. 1, art. XIII of the Constitution of the State of Alaska, and the
20 state election laws.
