3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 SEVENTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Proposing an amendment to the state
6 constitution limiting regular ses-
7 sions of the legislature to 90 days.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. Sec. 8, art. II, Constitution of the State of Alaska is
10 amended to read:

11 SECTION 8. The legislature shall convene each year on the fourth
12 Monday in January, but the month and day may be changed by law. Re-
13 gular sessions are limited to ninety days. The legislature may extend
14 the session for periods not to exceed 30 days each by concurrent resolu-
15 tions approved by a two-thirds majority vote of the membership of
16 each house.

17 *Sec. 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution shall be placed
18 before the voters of the state at the next statewide election in conformity
19 with sec. 1, art. XIII, Constitution of the State of Alaska, and the elec-
20 tion laws of the state.

21 * Sec. 3. If the amendment proposed by sec. 1 of this resolution is
22 approved by the voters, it becomes effective January 1, 1973.
