3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 SEVENTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Encouraging the BLM to release the
6 presently designated Campbell
7 Airstrip land with stipulations
8 for its highest and best use.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 WHEREAS land comprising that portion of the Campbell Airstrip area
11 declared surplus by the military is soon to be released to the state by
12 the Bureau of Land Management; and

13 WHEREAS it is universally acknowledged that sound land planning must
14 accompany the opening up of land areas in the public interest; and

15 WHEREAS large portions of the Campbell Airstrip land are most suitable
16 for recreational purposes and are important for water table recharge;

17 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska Legislature respectfully recommends
18 that the Bureau of Land Management release the designated Campbell Airstrip
19 land to the state with the stipulation that it be held in reserve status
20 until such time as it can be utilized under land planning principles which
21 recognize its highest and best use.
