3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 SEVENTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Relating to purchase of Alaskan
6 timber for use in public funded
7 projects.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

9 WHEREAS many millions of dollars will be expended by the state govern-
10 ment within the next couple of years to meet the extreme lack of housing
11 and public buildings; and

12 WHEREAS materials, and especially lumber, can be locally supplied if
13 the market presents itself to private industry; and

14 WHEREAS the key words always spoken when the economy of Alaska is being
15 discussed is "broader based industries"; and

16 WHEREAS the lumber and other associated building industries would
17 certainly go a long way in providing for this "broader base"; and

18 WHEREAS the imposition of a requirement that materials as far as
19 possible for the upcoming building undertakings of government groups like
20 ASHA and other agencies be Alaskan materials would generate industrial
21 development in many areas thus far untouched in Alaska;

22 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska Senate respectfully requests the Governor
23 to direct all state agencies, departments and public corporations to insti-
24 tute policies which provide for the purchase of materials and lumber which
25 are manufactured or milled in Alaska.
