5 Honoring Ralph Eugene Kvalvik.

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

7 WHEREAS Ralph Eugene Kvalvik, one of Alaska's outstanding professional  
8 guides, met an untimely death in March of this year; and

9 WHEREAS, after coming to Alaska in 1962, Eugene Kvalvik became a  
10 registered guide in 1964 and served with distinction in his chosen profes-  
11 sion; and

12 WHEREAS he was a member of the board of directors of the Alaska Profes-  
13 sional Hunter's Association; and

14 WHEREAS Eugene Kvalvik demonstrated his concern and love for Alaska's  
15 natural resource heritage through his active participation in the Sierra  
16 Club and the Alaska Conservation Society; and

17 WHEREAS as a writer and frequent contributor to national sporting publi-  
18 cations, including "Outdoor Life", he was instrumental in pointing out many  
19 of the hunting and guiding abuses within Alaska to the betterment of all  
20 the people of the state;

21 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Senate expresses its most sincere  
22 condolences to the family of Ralph Eugene Kvalvik and that this resolution  
23 serve as an expression of the high regard and esteem that his innumerable  
24 friends in the state had for him.
