6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

7 WHEREAS Susan Corrock of Ketchum, Idaho, a member of the United States  
8 ski team at the 1972 Winter Olympics at Sapporo, Japan, was the bronze  
9 medalist in the women's downhill competition; and

10 WHEREAS her parents, Mr. and Mrs. Jack Corrock, are without question  
11 the inspirational encouragement behind Susan's success in international ski  
12 competition where she is known as one of the most outstanding personalities  
13 on the United States team, not only in terms of her skiing ability but also  
14 for her dedication, character and winning personality on the slopes as well  
15 as in her nonathletic activities; and

16 WHEREAS her mother, Lila Corrock, was born and raised in Cordova,  
17 Alaska, thus linking her daughter, Susan, with the traditional interest of  
18 Alaskans in winter sports;
