3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 EIGHTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SPECIAL SESSION

5 Relating to pipeline impact on federal
6 programs in Alaska.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the federal government operates a number of programs operating
9 in Alaska that substantially affect the quality of life enjoyed by many
10 Alaskans; and

11 WHEREAS the construction of the Trans-Alaska Pipeline is imminent; and

12 WHEREAS pipeline construction and related activities will have a
13 tremendous impact in Alaska, its communities, and upon the services provided
14 by the federal, state and local governments; and

15 WHEREAS this impact, if unplanned, will result in a serious strain on
16 existing federal programs, thus adversely affecting the quality of life now
17 enjoyed by many Alaskans;

18 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska Legislature that the Federal Regional
19 Council for Region 10 is requested to complete a comprehensive study of the
20 various federal programs in Alaska to determine the impact on these programs
21 as a result of pipeline construction and related activity and to take
22 appropriate action immediately to meet the adverse effects that the impact
23 of pipeline construction activity may have on various federal programs.

24 COPIES of this resolution shall be sent to the Honorable Richard M.
25 Nixon, President of the United States; the Federal Regional Council for
26 Region 10; and to the Honorable Ted Stevens and the Honorable Mike Gravel,
27 U. S. Senators, and the Honorable Don Young, U. S. Representative, members
28 of the Alaska delegation in Congress.
