6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to legislative compensation; and  
7 providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 24.15 is amended by adding new sections to read:

10 Sec. 24.15.011. COMMISSION ON LEGISLATIVE COMPENSATION. (a) The  
11 Commission on Legislative Compensation is created.

12 (b) The commission consists of three members chosen from the gen-  
13 eral public, one of whom is appointed by the governor and one each of  
14 whom is appointed by the president of the senate and the speaker of the  
15 house.

16 (c) The term of office for commission members is for two years  
17 from the date of their respective appointments; a commission member may  
18 be reappointed for successive terms.

19 (d) Vacancies in office are filled in the same manner as original  
20 appointments.

21 (e) Commission members serve without compensation but are entitled  
22 to travel expenses and per diem as provided by law for other boards and  
23 commissions.

24 Sec. 24.15.021. DUTIES. (a) The commission shall select a chair-  
25 man from among its members.

26 (b) The commission shall conduct an ongoing review of legislative  
27 compensation to determine its appropriateness and shall submit its  
28 recommendations to the lieutenant governor no later than 90 days before  
29 each general election.

1           Sec. 24.15.031. RATIFICATION BY ELECTORATE. (a) The lieutenant  
2 governor shall place on each general election ballot the question:  
3 "Shall the recommendations of the Commission on Legislative Compensation  
4 be accepted? Yes [ ] No [ ]." A brief synopsis setting out the  
5 recommendations and changes made in existing compensation shall precede  
6 the ballot question.

          (b) Recommendations ratified by a majority of the qualified  
voters casting ballots on the question in a general election become  
effective at the beginning of the next regular session of the legis-  
lature.

\* Sec. 2. AS 24.15.010, 24.15.020 and 24.15.030 are repealed.

\* Sec. 3. Sec. 1 of this Act takes effect on the day after its passage  
and approval or on the day it becomes law without approval. Sec. 2 of this  
Act takes effect on the effective date of the first recommendation ratified  
under AS 24.15.031.
