For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to legislative compensation; and

providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 24.15 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10

Sec. 24.15.035. VOTER RATIFICATION. (a) An Act of the legis-  
11 lature, approved by the governor, adjusting the annual salary or annual  
12 allowance paid each member of the legislature under secs. 20 and 30 of  
13 this chapter may not go into effect until it is approved by a majority  
14 of the qualified voters voting on the question at the next statewide  
15 election following its enactment.

(b) Following the enactment of an adjustment in legislative com-  
17 pensation under secs. 20 and 30 of this chapter, the lieutenant governor  
18 shall place on the next statewide election ballot the following  
19 question: "Shall the Act of the legislature (insert citation to the  
20 legislative Act by session laws) concerning the adjustment in compensa-  
21 tion of members of the legislature be approved? Yes [ ] No [ ]".

A brief analysis setting out the changes made by the Act in existing  
23 legislative compensation shall precede the ballot question.

24

(c) Adjustments in legislative compensation approved by a majority  
25 of the voters voting on the question take effect on the first day of the  
26 next regular session of the legislature.

\* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval  
28 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
