6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to revenue sharing with local govern-  
7 ments for hospitals and health facilities; and providing  
8 for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 43.18.010(h) and (i) are repealed and re-enacted to read:

11 (h) During each fiscal year the state shall make payments as  
12 follows:

13 (1) \$1,000 per hospital bed to organized boroughs having  
14 health powers for each hospital bed actually used for patient care,  
15 limited to the number of beds provided for in the construction design  
16 of the hospital, or \$50,000 per hospital as the local government may  
17 determine;

18 (2) \$1,000 per hospital bed to each hospital located outside  
19 an organized borough having health powers for each hospital bed  
20 actually used for patient care, limited to the number of beds provided  
21 for in the construction design of the hospital, or \$50,000, as the  
22 hospital may determine;

23 (3) \$1,000 per bed to an organized borough or city outside an  
24 organized borough in which a health facility is operated for each bed  
25 actually used for patient care, limited to the number of beds provided  
26 for in the construction design of the health facility, or \$4,000 per  
27 health facility as the local government may determine;

28 (4) funds received by a local government under (1), (2)  
29 or (3) of this subsection shall be used for expenses of operation,

1 maintenance, or health services or facilities, as the local government  
2 or hospital outside an organized municipality determines;

3 (5) before funds may be distributed under this subsection,  
4 the commissioner of health and social services shall certify to the  
5 distributing agency that any accumulation of assets by nonprofit  
6 corporations or other recipients under this subsection are dedicated  
7 irrevocably to a public purpose.

8 (1) In (h) and (j) of this section

9 (1) "hospital" means a licensed hospital determined by the  
10 Department of Health and Social Services to be a general hospital; the  
11 term excludes facilities operated or wholly supported by the state or  
12 the federal government;

13 (2) "health facility" means public health centers, maternity  
14 homes and community mental health centers, facilities for the mentally  
15 or physically handicapped, nursing homes and convalescent centers which  
16 are licensed, when required, by the state under AS 18.20.010 - 18.20.130  
17 and are owned or operated or both by a local government or by a non-  
18 profit corporation or other nonprofit sponsor; the term excludes  
19 facilities operated or wholly supported by the state or the federal  
20 government.

(h) During each fiscal year the state shall make payments as

(1) \$1,000 per hospital bed to organized boroughs having

health powers for each hospital bed actually used for patient care,

5

limited to the number of beds provided for in the construction design

of the hospital, or \$50,000 per hospital for those hospitals with ten

7

or more beds or \$20,000 per hospital for those hospitals with less than

8

ten beds as the local government may determine;

(2) \$1,000 per hospital bed to each hospital located outside

an organized borough having health powers for each hospital bed

actually used for patient care, limited to the number of beds provided

for in the construction design of the hospital, or \$50,000 for those

hospitals with ten or more beds or \$20,000 per hospital for those

(3) \$1,000 per bed to an organized borough or city outside an

organized borough in which a health facility is operated for each bed

actually used for patient care, limited to the number of beds provided

for in the construction design of the health facility, or \$4,000 per

9

health facility as the local government may determine;

1 (4) funds received by a local government under (1), (2)  
2 or (3) of this subsection shall be used for expenses of operation,  
3 maintenance, or health services or facilities, as the local government  
4 or hospital outside an organized municipality determines;

5 (5) before funds may be distributed under this subsection,  
6 the commissioner of health and social services shall certify to the  
7 distributing agency that any accumulation of assets by nonprofit
