5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to registration of voters."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 15.07.130 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

9 Sec. 15.07.130. ELIMINATION OF EXCESS NAMES. (a) Within 30 days
10 after the completion of the canvass of the returns of a general election
11 and before January 1 of the following year, the area election super-
12 visor shall examine the register of voters.

13 (b) When a registered voter has not voted in at least one of the
14 last three consecutive statewide elections, the voter shall be advised
15 by the area election supervisor by certified mail sent to his last
16 known address that his registration will be cancelled unless he indi-
17 cates within 60 days on forms furnished by the lieutenant governor
18 his desire to remain registered. If an election board in a precinct
19 does not receive the required election materials under AS 15.15.050 to
20 enable the board to conduct the election and the registered voters
21 in that precinct to cast their ballots, then that statewide election
22 may not be counted as one in which a registered voter has failed to
23 vote.
