BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 09.55.090 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

10

(5) failure to consummate the marriage at the time of the

11

marriage and continuing at the commencement of the action.

* Sec. 2. AS 09.55.110(1) is amended to read:

(1) failure to consummate the marriage [IMPOTENCY EXISTING]

at the time of the marriage and continuing at the commencement of the

15

action;

* Sec. 3. AS 25.05.031 is amended to read:

Sec. 25.05.031. VOIDABLE MARRIAGE. If either party to a marriage

18

is incapable of consenting to it at the time of the marriage for want

19

of marriageable age of consent or sufficient understanding, or if

20

the consent of either party is obtained by force or fraud, or if

21

either party fails to consummate the marriage, the marriage is voidable

22

but only at the suit of the party under the disability or upon whom

23

the force or fraud is imposed.
