6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to maternity leave; and providing
7 for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 39.20.280 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

10 Sec. 39.20.280. MATERNITY LEAVE. A female employee, otherwise
11 qualified for a leave of absence, may take a maximum of six months
12 maternity leave immediately preceding and following childbirth. This
13 leave is chargeable first to sick leave and if that is not sufficient,
14 then to annual leave, providing that if after sick and annual leave
15 are exhausted the employee may go on leave without pay for the
16 balance of the six-month period. A person taking maternity leave
17 shall otherwise be treated as all other employees taking sick or
18 annual leave of absence.

19 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and
20 approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.

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
