6 For an Act entitled: "An Act authorizing Monte Carlo nights for certain
7 organizations and associations."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 05.15 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 CHAPTER 15. BINGO, RAFFLES, MONTE CARLO NIGHTS
11 AND ICE POOLS.

12 ARTICLE 4. MONTE CARLO NIGHTS.

13 Sec. 05.15.300. AUTHORIZATION AND LIMITATIONS. (a) Monte Carlo
14 nights may be permitted under this chapter and to the extent permitted
15 may not be held to be in violation of the state's gaming or gambling
16 laws.

17 (b) Permits for the activity in (a) of this section may be
18 issued by the commissioner of revenue only to qualified organizations
19 as defined in sec. 210 of this chapter.

20 * Sec. 2. AS 05.15.100 is amended to read:

21 Sec. 05.15.100. COMMISSIONER OF REVENUE MAY ISSUE PERMITS. The
22 commissioner of revenue may issue a permit to a qualified organization.
23 The permit gives the organization the privilege of conducting bingo,
24 raffles and lotteries, ice classics, dog mushers' contests, fish
25 derbies, Monte Carlo nights and contests of skill.

26 * Sec. 3. AS 05.15.180 is amended to read:

27 Sec. 05.15.180. LIMITATIONS ON AUTHORIZED ACTIVITY. (a) Except
28 for conducting Monte Carlo nights this [THIS] chapter does not autho-
29 rize the use of playing cards, dice, roulette wheels, coin-operated

1 instruments or machines, or other objects or instruments used, designed,
2 or intended primarily for gaming or gambling or any other method or
3 implement not expressly authorized by the commissioner.

4 (b) No activity may be licensed under this chapter, except Monte
5 Carlo nights as provided for under sec. 300 of this chapter, unless
6 it existed in the state in substantially the same form and was con-
7 ducted in substantially the same manner before January 1, 1959.

8 * Sec. 4. AS 05.15.210 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

9 (19) "Monte Carlo night" means the conducting of one or
10 more games of chance within a single building or enclosure for a
11 specified period of time not to exceed eight hours and for which script
12 is sold and cashed in from a central banking facility and used as the
13 medium of exchange at all gaming tables.
