4 EIGHTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to relocation of the capital of the  
7 state."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. There shall be placed on the ballot at the next general  
10 election the question: "Shall the capital of the state be moved from Juneau  
11 to a location within the area bounded by the meridians of longitude 146  
12 degrees and 152 degrees west of Greenwich and the parallels of latitude 60  
13 degrees and 66 degrees north? Yes [ ] No [ ]".

14 \* Sec. 2. If the referendum provided in sec. 1 of this Act is adopted,  
15 the governor shall appoint a capital relocation commission consisting of  
16 one person from each senatorial district. The commission shall make recom-  
17 mendations to the next session of the legislature for the location of the  
18 state capital as provided by the referendum. The legislature shall designate  
19 the most appropriate site from among the recommendations of the commission.
