6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the penalties for driving a motor
7 vehicle while under the influence of intoxicating
8 liquor or drugs."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 28.35.030 is amended to read:

11 Sec. 28.35.030. DRIVING WHILE UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF INTOXICATING
12 LIQUOR OR DRUGS. A person who, while under the influence of intoxicating
13 liquor or narcotic drugs, operates or drives an automobile, motorcycle
14 or other motor vehicle in the state upon conviction is punishable by a
15 fine of not more than \$1,000, or by imprisonment for not more than one
16 year, or by both. In the case of a first offense his punishment shall
17 include at least two days imprisonment, and in the case of subsequent
18 offenses his punishment shall include at least 10 days imprisonment.
19 In addition, his operator's license may be limited or suspended in
20 accordance with AS 28.15.260(a).
