6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to teachers' bargaining groups."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 14.20.560(a) is amended to read:

9 (a) When a majority of the certificated employees in a school
10 district have designated an educational organization of their own
11 choosing to bargain for them, the organization shall be recognized by
12 the school board as the bargaining agent for all the certificated
13 staff, except school administrators, including superintendents, assis-
14 stant superintendents, principals and assistant principals [OF SCHOOLS].

15 The membership of any such recognized educational organization shall
16 be composed principally of those employed in the teaching profession
17 in Alaska.

18 * Sec. 2. AS 14.20.560(f) is amended to read:

19 (f) Nothing in this section shall be construed to prevent certifi-
20 cated administrative personnel groups, including superintendents,
21 assistant superintendents, principals and assistant principals, from
22 having the right to negotiate [INDEPENDENTLY OF THE OTHER CERTIFICATED
23 PERSONNEL IF THEY CHOOSE TO DO SO AS THE RESULT OF A SECRET BALLOT].
