6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the qualifications of the executive
7 officer of the nursing board."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 08.68.111(b) is amended to read:

10 (b) The executive officer shall be a nurse having a bachelor's
11 degree or higher, currently licensed in the state and with not less
12 than five years of active nursing experience, of which not less than
13 two years within the preceding five years shall have been in an
14 administrative or a teaching capacity in an accredited institution
15 acceptable to the board. If a licensed professional nurse holding a
16 bachelor's degree is not available to fill the position of executive
17 officer, the board may waive the requirement for a bachelor's degree and
18 appoint a licensed professional nurse possessing other qualifications in
19 education and administrative experience which the board considers
20 acceptable. However, the appointee shall complete the requirements for
21 the award of a bachelor's degree in four years after appointment to the
22 position of executive officer.
