6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the transfer of exceptional
7 children in the state."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 14.30.285 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

10 Sec. 14.30.285. EXCEPTIONAL CHILDREN IN THE STATE. (a) The
11 Department of Education shall institute a statewide program for the
12 education of exceptional children, to insure that whenever possible
13 children are educated in the state at locations in or near their
14 resident school district.

15 (b) When an adequate program of education for an exceptional child
16 is not available in a school district, the identified exceptional child
17 may be sent to another school district or in-state educational program
18 that will meet his needs.

19 (c) If a school district approves the enrollment of an exceptional
20 child in another school district or in-state institution and the child
21 is enrolled, the child's education expenses shall be paid for as
22 follows:

23 (1) the sending school district shall pay the receiving
24 district or institution an amount of money equal to the sending dis-
25 trict's local cost per pupil rate;

26 (2) the Department of Education shall pay the remainder of
27 the annual cost of the child's education above that provided for in (1)
28 of this subsection.

29 (d) For the purposes of this section a child's education expenses

1 are limited to the actual cost of necessary care, transportation and
2 instruction, including room and board, while attending the designated
3 institution.
