6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to flammable fabrics."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 18.60 is amended by adding new sections to read:

9 ARTICLE 9. FLAMMABLE FABRICS.

10 Sec. 18.60.800. MANUFACTURE, SALE, IMPORTATION, ADVERTISEMENT
11 PROHIBITED. The manufacture, sale, importation into the state for
12 delivery or sale, or the advertisement for sale of any fabric or
13 related material that fails to conform to an applicable standard or
14 regulation concerning flammability issued by the United States Depart-
15 ment of Commerce under the Flammable Fabrics Act (15 U.S.C. secs. 1191 -
16 1204, as amended; 67 Stat. 111) is prohibited.

17 Sec. 18.60.810. PENALTY. A person who wilfully violates sec. 800
18 of this chapter is guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction is
19 punishable by a fine of not more than \$1,000, or by imprisonment for
20 not more than a year, or by both.
