6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to flammable fabrics; and providing for
7 an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 18.60 is amended by adding new sections to read:

10 ARTICLE 9. FLAMMABLE FABRICS.

11 Sec. 18.60.800. MANUFACTURE, SALE, IMPORTATION, ADVERTISEMENT
12 PROHIBITED. The manufacture, sale, importation into the state for
13 delivery or sale, or the advertisement for sale of any fabric or
14 related material that fails to conform to an applicable standard or
15 regulation concerning flammability issued by the United States Depart-
16 ment of Commerce under the Flammable Fabrics Act (15 U.S.C. secs. 1191 -
17 1204, as amended; 67 Stat. 111) is prohibited.

18 Sec. 18.60.810. PENALTY. A person who wilfully violates sec. 800
19 of this chapter is guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction is
20 punishable by a fine of not more than \$1,000, or by imprisonment for
21 not more than a year, or by both.

22 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval
23 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
