5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the definition of dependent
7 child; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 47.25.410(3) is amended to read:

10 (3) "dependent child" means a needy child under 18 years of
11 age who is deprived of parental support or care by reason of the death,
12 continued absence from the home, or physical or mental incapacity of a
13 parent, or the unemployment of his parent as determined in accordance
14 with the standards prescribed by the Secretary of Health, Education
15 and Welfare under 42 U.S.C. 607, and who is living with his father,
16 mother, grandfather, grandmother, brother, sister, stepfather, step-
17 mother, stepbrother, stepsister, uncle, aunt, first cousin, nephew, or
18 niece in a place of residence maintained by one or more of these
19 relatives as his or their own home, and includes a child

20 (A) who would come within the meaning of dependent
21 child except for his removal after April 30, 1961, from the home
22 of a relative as a result of a judicial determination to the effect
23 that continuation therein would be contrary to the welfare of the
24 child,

25 (B) for whose placement the department is responsible,

26 (C) who has been placed in a foster family home as a
27 result of such determination, and

28 (D) who received aid under this plan in and for the
29 month in which court proceedings leading to such determination

1 were initiated;

2 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval
3 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
